by Raspberry United Methodist Men's Club

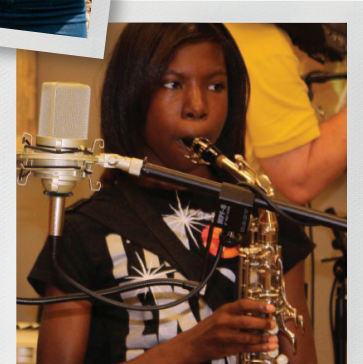
