

A New Kind of Clinic for the Delta

Working uninsured now have a low-cost option for their primary health care.

Through partnerships with local clinics in four counties (Humphreys, Leflore, Sunflower, and Washington), Delta Health Alliance is providing affordable primary care for uninsured workers.



What's new is the way these clinics operate.

In addition to the clinical care that a patient receives, other professionals are available in these clinics to help with prescription drug medications, dietary advice, arranging appointments with specialists, managing chronic diseases like diabetes and high blood pressure, smoking cessation, and immunizations. We describe it as helping a patient navigate the health care system. We provide information about healthier lifestyles, about others who can provide assistance to you, and about your rights and responsibilities as a patient. And we've got the most up-to-date technology at these clinics to make sure you get the best care possible.

We call these clinics medical homes because they are your one-stop place to healthy living. Our teams of nurse practitioners, nurses, licensed social workers, community health workers, and registered dietitians are working together and coordinating care for patients. And they are helping patients take more control of their care and become more active in making decisions about their choices.
