

# Indianola & Early Education

In 2011, the W. K. Kellogg Foundation provided a grant to Delta Health Alliance to fund an exciting and innovative initiative in Indianola - the Indianola Promise Community Early Education Collaborative.

The goal is to help more than 1,200 children over a three-year period become better prepared to start school and to stay prepared while in elementary school.

One program starts in the home with infants, another reaches three and four year olds, and another focuses on students in first through sixth grades. Another partner works with parents. And then there's the Promise School, an eight-week summer camp for rising kindergarteners.

Thanks to the Kellogg Foundation, there's a lot of good happening right now in Indianola. Teachers, parents, administrators, and students are all working together.
